Good design doesn't have to be expensive. Here are some tips on how you can make your interiors special without spending a fortune:

Simple, bold and dramatic

• **Be simple.** Don't be afraid of your good design ideas or your taste. Establish a good design "concept" and then stick to your plan. The simpler the better most often, the more expensive it can be.

• **Be bold.** Sometimes, some walls/large vertical stripes are more dramatic than small stripes are. Think about making those stripes horizontal. Also consider, for instance, when buying a plant, choosing the most substantial possible over a small potted plant. When in doubt, think big and dramatic.

Colorful surprise

• **Go for something.** One of the easiest — and affordable — ways to make a striking design statement is to incorporate color that normally wouldn't be a way that is unexpected and exciting.

• **Use wallpaper.** Instead of using wallpaper with a floral pattern to create a fun look, use a wallpaper when the pattern is a bright color, like yellow. Look for the pattern on the wall, but the repeat now creates a subtle look.

• **Don't be afraid.** Oh, never stop with the fresh and unexpected that's made that the good news when using color, is that it is just that — just! If you just love it, you love enough!

• **Use some new.** Think about how you use materials normally intended for one purpose in one and interesting way. I once applied perforated metal to the walls of the bathroom to create a modern look. I also used the material as a back splash in the kitchen. The decorative material used here unexpectedly was given the same unexpected behavior. And it didn't add much to the overall cost of the project.
